I, William Lenca, in a field survey on Aug. 04, 19 95, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 16" - S65°W - 14 lks; Hemlock, 24" - N54°W - 5 lks. All original evidence has been destroyed by county road improvements.

1984: L.C.R.C. No. 596, recorded by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, states that a Deep-1 magnet was set in place of a found iron pin in Road intersection. TIES: Deep-1 - SW - 43.6' (found); Pin - NW - 46.1' (found).

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In our 1995 Remonumentation Survey in T33N-R27W, we recovered a "Deep - 1" magnet in the centerline of County Roads running North - South and East - West. This monument fits with existing lines of occupation, has been used by local surveyors for several years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box:

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with a steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
