I, William Lenca, in a field survey on May 13, 19 97 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Sugar, 8" - N03°E - 09 lks.; Hemlock, 12" - S50°W - 19 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
- 1991: L.C.R.C. No. 911 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states "Found 5/8" dia. iron in line with county road centerlines north and west and in line with ancient fence line to the east." TIES: Maple, 7" - S87°E - 107.20'; W. Birch, 3" - S23°E - 56.04'; Apple, 9" - S74°W - 46.61'; W. Ash, 8" - N12°W - 73.70'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 5/8 inch x 21 inch Iron rod in line with the centerline of county roads running north and west and in line with an ancient fence running east. We also found the B.T.'s as described in L.C.R.C. No. 911 (see part A). This corner has been used by local surveyors for several years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:

5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/2" dia. Alum. cap marked "WITNESS MARKER"	East	26.45 feet

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
