

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Hemlock, 14" - S28°W - 20 lks.; Lynn, 6" - N63°E - 21 lks.; All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by farming activities.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner at a very old established fence corner, fences run South and West from this location. This position fits within 5 feet of splitting the mile, but falls 54 feet West of a straight line between Section Corners. We searched the area and were unable to find original evidence or evidence of subsequent restoration. We therefore accepted the location of the old fence corner as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner Set 3/4" dia. x 4' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner.
