8. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We computed the single proportional location for this corner, traversed in to it and searched the area. We found no evidence of the original corner accessories, or evidence of subsequent restoration. We then set the corner midpoint on a line between section corners. The corner fails on the northeast side of a ridge and 99' south of a swamp edge which fits the G.L.O. record, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
