

I, William Lenca , in a field survey on June 03 , 19 98 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 comers, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - 1848: Original Survey Township Boundary by H. Brevoort, Jr. B.T.'s Birch, 6" N75°W 18 lks.; Hemlock, 16" S51°W 40 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
  - 1852: Sectional Subdivision by Francis Coleman B.T.'s Cedar, 20" N15°E 08 lks.; Cedar, 18" S50°E 45 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
  - 1991: Land Corner Recordation Certificate Number 901 by William Lenca states, "Found 3/4" dia. Iron Pipe in center of C.R. N-S and in line with occupation East." TIES: 8" Tamarack Scr. NBT, N46°E, 60.00 feet; Nail in Power Pole, S79°E, 33.08'; Nail in 8" Elm, S88°W, 73.18'; Nail in 6" Spruce, N17°W, 130.40'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a 1/2" square Iron Bar inside of a 3/4" x 18" Iron Pipe and 4 witnesses as described in Land Corner Recordation Certificate Number 901 by William Lenca, RLS 26461. This position has been used for many years, fits existing lines of occupation, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
