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I, \_\_\_\_\_, In a field survey on \_\_\_\_\_, 19\_\_\_\_, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

**NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.**

**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

- 1852: Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Cedar, 14" - N24°E - 48 lks; Maple - 16", S58°W - 18 lks - All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.
- 1982: L.C.R.C. No. 542 recorded by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states that a 3/4" x 18" Iron Pipe was placed by single proportionate measurement - B.T.'s - 5" W. Birch - N40°W - 59.72'; 20" Cedar - N63°E - 17.27'.

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:**

Found 3/4" x 18" Iron Pipe and B.T.'s mentioned in part "A". This corner was established by single proportionate measurement in a 1982 survey of Section 16. The corner position falls in line with the centerline of a county road running West and South from this location, and is accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

Set 2-1/2" dia. alum. pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:

22" dia. Cedar (Ex. B.T.)	N63°E	17.27 feet	Scr. NBT

**NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.**
