E-9) 1909 Cavanagh Survey in Section 20: Corner was used but no witnesses given.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

E-9) Section corner common to Sections 20, 21, 28 and 29

Found Iron in centerline of East-West Road and $\pm 6'$ West of North-South centerline. This corner is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
