

- M5 Standard Corner common to Section 12 & 13, T23N, R5W and Sections 7 & 18, T23N, R4W Found 1/2" x 18" smooth iron rod with cap #14102 with an old 21/2" x 0.6' long stake point alongside and also a buggy axle guard post. No evidence of witnesses #1, 2, 3, or 4. Fits remains of witnesses #5, 6, & 7. Corner falls in Tag alder swamp. 1/2" CIR accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
