- 1-8 1/4 Cor. common to Sec. 22 & 23-Found 4" wide X 1/4" X 35" long Iron Sleigh runner upright in swamp by projecting the fence line remains South from North. Fence remains also go East. Also found 1" X 4" of rotten wood stake where runner was found. Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
