B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 1" Pipe 1.5' south of the centerline of E-W asphalt road. No occupation is visible to the south and old fence and plow line runs to the north. Corner falls in a road cut of approximately 6 feet. Upon excavation, pipe was found to be beside a 4"x7"x8" blue stone. At 14" deep, I found an old car axle beside the pipe. One OCRC witness is standing and measures consistent to what would be the face of a 30" Cottonwood.

This Pipe and Axle was accepted as the best evidence of the corner and was accepted as being a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be in another location. The Iron was lowered and I placed a 4"x20" Harrison Cast Iron Monument, stamped "County Surveyor" & "26457" above them at the found position...
