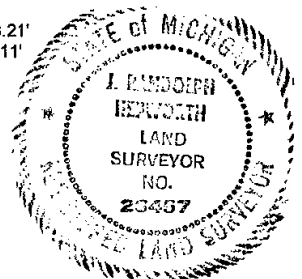

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.**

I found a 3/4" Pipe inside a monument box without a lid in the centerline of N-S Road and 3' North of centerline of E-W Road as described by LCRC 100100 & 100367. Only Witness Nos. 9, 11, and 12 are standing and are now cut-off stumps. Upon removal of the pipe, I found it to be 12" long and set above a 5/8" x30" Iron that was stuck inside the bottom of the Pipe. I did not find the stone referred to by OCRC.

I accept the pipe in the monument box as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner should be at another location.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**
