B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

are! I found a 4" dia. concrete monument with 1/2" Iron encased, projecting 4" above the ground. Two of Roser, LCRC 100279, witnesses are the same as Salisbury, 1921 witnesses. Witness #1 is still standing. Witness #2 is now dead. This monument is located 3 feet west and 17 feet north of the northwest end of the pavement road. This corner is referenced in the plat of OTTAWATTAMIE PARK and in APACHE HILLS and measures to other corners in those leads to consider the plat of OTTAWATTAMIE PARK and in APACHE HILLS are measures to other corners in those plats close to recorded distances.

Laccept the concrete monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner should be at another location. As this corner monument is a substantial marker in good and undisturbed condition, I left it as it was found.
