

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applies in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- E-9 Found 1/2"x18" rebar with broken plastic cap and all of Cavanagh wits. (Did not use Triple Oak, bad condition) Corner is 2' North of E-W C/L gravel road and is inline with C/L gravel road to north. Accepted found rebar as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- F-9 Found ½" CIR#21575 4' North of E-W C/L gravel road. Accepted found ½"CIR as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E-9 Found 1/2" rebar with broken cap, replaced with 1"x3' galvanized pipe with P.S. cap#33981 down 0.6' below grade.
