

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no evidence of the original corner or accessories. At the corner position I found a 1" O.D. pipe with a very rusty yellow Forest Service location poster facing it. The pipe works very well with GLO distances to the north and south. I accepted the 1" iron pipe as the section corner and Monumented it as such.
