thereby making the corner 4 feet long. Sometimes a solid tile, with a cross in the top was used, and sometimes a 1/2" iron bars were added to the tile. Notes of the work were kept in ledgers, and given to the townships, and 5 of the townships have been recorded in the County records.

This corner is recorded in the Rose Lake Twp. Book Pages 30 and 31 as tile and rod, dated 6 June 1918. Witness gone.
