

I found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found no remains of the original Corner or accessories. I found a 5/8" iron set by an unknown surveyor. It falls 12" below gravel at the intersection of the centerline of a county road to East and old fenceline to the North and South. This 5/8" iron works well with the Section Corners to the East and West. I accepted it as the 1/2 Corner and placed a 3" diameter aluminum cap on it.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" iron pin with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; S.2, S.11; 1/4; T.47N, R.38W; 1998; P.S. 37273. I also established a reference monument (R.M.) to the North, a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the 1/4 Corner is \$ 01° E a distance of 33.30 feet.
