

I found no remains of the original comer or accessories. The area of the Corner now falls in a four way intersection. I found a punched railroad spike 2" below pavement at the intersection of North-South Gardner Road and East-West "One Mile Road". Distances to Corners to West and South work well with GLO and occupation.

I accepted the railroad spike as the Section Corner.
