

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original corner or bearing trees were found. Area has been farmed extensively. Corner position is on an abandoned County Road, built in the early 1900's. Corner was set by a single proportionate measurement on a line between the NW &NE Corner of Section 8. This corner was one of the corners re-monumented in a Block of 6 Sections in which all original corners were re-established.
