A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by William A. Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor in 1847. Set Cedar Post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33 has been farmed for 60 + years. A fence was found running North and South 75 feet East of the calculated corner position. This fence was installed about 30 years ago by the present owner. Checking the fence $\frac{1}{4}$ mile North there is an obvious deflection to the East. I met with the owner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and pointed this out to him. Corner was re-established about 75 feet West of the existing fence line. Corner was set by single proportionate measure and on the Town Line between the monumented South $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 32 and the Southeast Corner of Section 33.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" split base aluminum pipe with a 3" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N, T47N, R41W, S4, S33, $\frac{1}{4}$, 1999, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.
