I, Earl W. Applekamp, in a field survey on Nov. 12, 1999 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Corner established by William Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, June 13, 1848. Set Sugar Post.

ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

Lynn 10" S65°W 7 Links (4.62 Feet)
 Y. Birch 18" N65°E 24 Links (15.84 Feet)

In 1973 a drill steel was set at the intersection of a graded up road and a fence line running East & West to mark the $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner. This was used for the South line of the Plat of "Leisure Acres" recorded in Liber 39, page 215 on March 26, 1974.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found the 1" Drill Steel. The graded road has numerous trees growing on it. The fence line is all down. I accepted the 1" Drill Steel as being the only logical position for the corner, and monumented it as shown below.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I replaced the 1" Drill Steel with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with a 3" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation T49N R42W, S28, S33, $\frac{1}{4}$, 1999, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.

 Nail in 12" Spruce S57°E 33.89' - 6' Steel Sign Post North 0.78'
