A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(F12) Center of Section 33. Not established in the original survey. Corner is shown has having been established on a mining company survey ca. 1907-1910 of the subdivision of Sections 31, 32, and 33. Dimensions from Quarter corner E12 and 1/16 corner #5, Sec. 33 are given as S88 deg. 22'30"E, 2767.4' and S1 deg. 50'30"W, 1318.0', respectively. No monument type noted. The survey drawing, or a copy of it, resides at the offices of Steven Hein PS, Laurium, MI.

(9-Sec. 32) East 1/16 corner, Section 32. Not established in the original survey.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(F12) No monumentation was found at the corner position. Reestablished the mining company position using found monumentation on Section 33 and the bearing and distance measurements given on the drawing. Specifically, the corner was reestablished S88 deg. 22' 16"E, 2766.95' from Quarter corner E12, and S1 deg. 47'03"W, 1319.19' from 1/16 corner #5, Sec. 33 (True bearings). This position was chosen as it seems to fit best with the various mining company measurements which concern the location of this corner.

(9-Sec. 32) Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Center of Section 1255.11' west and Quarter corner 1255.11' east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(F12) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: 6" Sugar N52W 13.2' mrkd "C1/4 BT" Y.Birch N55E 28.7' 5" Y.Birch S35E 4.7' do 19" Cedar S01E 27.5' do Set Cedar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.
