I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 04/13/2010 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a
Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(F11) Quarter corner common to Sections 28-33. 1846 - Established by S.W.Higgins Deputy Surveyor,
midway and on the Section line between Section corners 40.05 chains east and west. Set post. Cedar
10 N71W 4 links, Hemlock 8 S45E 12 links. Ca. 1907-1910 Corner shown on old mining company survey
drawing, probably a result of surveys by W.B.Smith and/or Engineers Fesing and Gibbs. The drawing
shows the corner (monument description not noted) midway and on a straight line between Section
corners 2652.4' easterly and westerly, the bearing of the Section line being N87 deg. 28'W. 1/16
corner #2, Section 33 is also shown, midway between Section and Quarter corners. The drawing, or a
copy of it, resides at the offices of Steven Hein PS, Laurium, MI. 1980 - Reestablished by
K.L.Sackett RLS "at spot of old section subdivision of 1900. Reestablished by projecting line from
section corner across 1/16 corner and double the distance". Set 1"IDx30" I.pipe with 4" alum. cap.
5" Elm N36E 41.5', 4" Maple N60W 13.0', 8" Balsam S40E 28.1'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(F11) Found the 1980 monument in good condition, at the record position, and at record bearing and
distance from the remaining two 1980 NBTs. The Balsam SE and Maple NW are in good condition, with
old blazes visible. Bearings and distances to adjacent Section corners were found to be N87 deg.
18'23"W 2652.84' and S87 deg. 31'45"E 2651.00' (true bearings). This position also checks with 1/16
corners #2 and #5, Section 33, both shown on the mining company survey drawing. I accept the
monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(F11) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap
stamped to identify the corner.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
9" Balsam S36E 28.3' old blazes (1980 NBT)
6" Maple in clump N58W 13.2' do do
12" W.Spruce N71E 21.5' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
4" Sugar S27W 12.7' do
Set cedar post adjacent. Bearings magnetic.
