1949-1950 Ned Hawley, Timber Cruiser, found the 12" Sugar B.T. with a blaze facing Southeast and "Marks faint" on it. He put in a %" x 4' iron pipe with a coupling on top at record bearing and distance from this B.T.

Billy/D. Buckler, P.S., for Michigan DNR, found a ¾" Iron pipe with a 30" Hard Maple original B.T. N 67°W, 25 links from it. He also found 1/2" Iron pipe N 33°W, 38 links. Ties:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I recovered a 1/2 iron pipe with a coupling on top at the corner position as called for by Ned Hawley. It was at the correct bearing and distance form the 12" Sugar B.T. (Now a 30 +" fallen Hard Maple.) I also recovered 2 of Billy Buckler's B.T.'s which indicate he used and accepted this same pipe. I also found another 5/8" iron pipe N 30°W, 25.08" from the corner. This also was set by Ned Hawley (in 1955) N 07°E, 22 links from the same existing B.T. He was unsure whether the existing B.T. was the 10" or 12" Sugar. 1 cut open the grown over portions of the fallen B.T. The remaining part of the blaze faced southeast supporting Hawley's original conclusion, and Billy Buckler's, that this B.T. was the 12° Sugar and that the 3/4" iron pipe is at the correct comer position. I replaced the pipe with a county monument.


