- 195? Victor A. Arcand, R.L.S. 10678, in survey for "Mary M. Craig, Potato River Property" (partial copy of survey at Ontonagon County Equalization), placed drill steels on section line at 303.7', 420.80', 537.9', 889.20, and 1006.30' West of a drill steel at the "South 1/4 Corner of Section 33".
 - B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

The original Meander Corner and accessories have been destroyed by extreme shoreline erosion.

I recovered the drill steel that Arcand called the South 1/4 Corner of Section 33.

I determined this corner to be the North 1/4 Corner of Section 4, T51N, R40W after extensive retracement in sections to the South. I also recovered drill steels at the following distances West of the Arcand 1/4 Corner: 302.32', 418.64', 535.54', and 886.12'. The drill steels line up well with one another. I used the drill steels to re-establish the Section line and established a Witness Corner to the Meander Corner on this line, 483.54' East of GLO Meander Corner position. Original Meander Corner falls in Lake Superior.
