Original corner and accessories have been destroyed by shoreline erosion.	
I found the corners from the above surveys as well as a 4" square concrete monument on the North right-of-way of Lakesh Drive. The concrete monument works well for line with Assessor's Plat and Robert Mick survey to South. It fails 230 feet S of the water's edge. Land between the monument and the water's edge is drifting sand.	
Therefore, I held the concrete monument as the Witness Corner to the Meander Corner and placed a 2" diameter stamped aluminum cap on it.	d
