I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 09/17/14 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K3) Section corner common to 1-2-11-12. 1997 - Remonumented by Thomas P. O'Brien PS 21274 with a Schoolcraft County monument. 13" Cedar S10°E 23.48', 13" Cedar S09°W 22.17', 10" Cedar S18°W 12.93', 7" twin Cedar S16°E 22.40', 8" Cedar N65°W 138.30', 6" Tamarack N66°E 96.79', Carsonite Post North 1.0'. Corner approved by Schoolcraft County Peer Group 11/12/97 and recorded in L 4, P 140.

(14-Sec. 1) South 1/16 corner between Section 1 T42N-R16W and Section 6 T42N-R15W. 1967 - Established by Frank J. Bray, RLS midway and on line between section corner to south and 1/4 corner to north. Set 1" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap. 17" R.Pine S37°E 14 links, 17" R.Pine N34°W 39 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K3) The 1997 monument was not recovered. At the position reestablished at record bearing and distance from the 1997 witnesses, I found a hole in the mucky soil which I accepted as the remaining physical evidence of the position of the 1997 monument. This position checks with the 1997 witnesses of record, all of which are in good condition and remeasured as shown below. Set 1" ID iron pipe with 4" Michigan Dept. of Conservation cap at said position, flush with the ground surface.

(14-Sec. 1) Found the 1967 monument in good condition, substantially at the record position, and at record bearing and distance from the 1967 witnesses, now both rotted stumps. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful establishment of the position of the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K3) Set 1" ID x36" I.pipe with 4" Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, flush. Found measuring nails in the following witnesses of record:

16" Cedar S10°W 22.11'
14" twin Cedar S04°E 23.52'
11" twin Cedar S18°E 22.50'
11" Cedar N62°W 137.87'
6" Tamarack N66°E 96.8'
