I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 03/16/2011 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E12) Quarter corner common to Sections 32 and 33. 1850 - Established by Guy Carleton, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, midway and on the line between Section corners 39.69 chains north and south. Set post. Cedar 10" N70W 4 links, Cedar 8" S51E 4 links. 1979 - Corner monumented by Billy D. Buckler RLS. Set 1" pipe with 4" alum. cap. 8" Cedar N54E 5.1', 7" Cedar N42W 11.0'. On a drawing dated June 18 1979, Mr. Buckler notes the distance north to E11 as 2620.2' and the angle between the Section line and the E-W 1/4 line (in NE quadrant) of 89 deg. 52'. 1991 - Thomas P. O'Brien PS records 1/16 cor. #8, east of E12, noting that its position was established by "section subdivision". According to an undated partial sketch of Section 33 by Mr. O'Brien, the mile E11 to E13 measures 5196.72', E13 having been remonumented by himself in accord with "found maples which match GLO corner tree and witness tree pattern". Mr. O'Brien does not indicate E12 on the sketch in any manner whatsoever but describes 1/16 cor. #3 (noted as "no corner set") as being 1299.18' south of E11. 2002 - Robert Goodreau PS notes on a survey drawing for Seney Township that the corner is recorded in L1, P.219 Schoolcraft Co. Records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E12) Found the 1979 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the remaining 1979 witness Cedar N42W 11.0', now 12" DBH with old open blaze. The method which Mr. Buckler used to determine the corner position is not known. No explanation or formal Land Corner Certificate was found. Distance north to E11 was found to be 2619.04' and the angle between the Section line and the E-W 1/4 line (to the E1/4 cor. of Sec. 33) was found to be 89 deg. 50'58". The notation by Mr. Goodreau appears to be in error, as no record of this corner is to be found in L.1, P.219 of Land Corner Records. The position of Mr. O'Brien's monuments (1/16 #8 and Center F12) suggest that either these corners were set in erroneous positions or that their positions were not controlled by the 1979 monument at E12. I accept the DNR monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(E12) Fd. 1"ID Iron pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: 12" Cedar S05W 0.8' fd. blazed on 4 sides 12" Cedar N41W 11.4' open blaze (1979 NBT) 7" Cedar S63W 4.2' mrkd "1/4S NBT" 5" Cedar S66E 27.8' do Bearings are magnetic.
