The 1953 NBT R.Pine is in good condition with open blaze and some scribing visible. Found two additional NBTs, marked by persons unknown, blazed, scribed, with measuring nail and washer, and described below. Found remains of original Y.Pine B.T. 18" N15W 19 links, now a rotted stump. Accepted the "C.C." monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
