B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C-11) Corner Common to Sections 29, 30, 31 & 32, T 2 S, R 10 E

Found 1/2" iron rod in monument box. Distance to C-12 measured 2628.26' (WPA = 2628.31'). Corner was confirmed with irons found in "Frank H. Fellrath's Subdivision" as recorded in Liber 33 of Plats, Page 58, Wayne County records; "Rob't. M. Grindley's Sub. No. 9 of Little Farms" as recorded in Liber 34 of Plats, Page 5, Wayne County records; "Fellrath's Subdivision" as recorded in Liber 39 of Plats, Page 19, Wayne County records; and Dearborn Grove Sub. No. 1" as recorded in Liber 42, Page 22, Wayne County records.



C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C-11) Corner Common to Sections 29, 30, 31 & 32, T 2 S, R 10 E

Found 1/2" iron rod in monument box and placed Wayne County brass disk stamped with license #21566 over 1/2" iron rod at the intersection of Carlisle Avenue and Beech-Daly Road, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
