

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

E10 - GLO - Set 1/4 post, by J. Brink - 1839

Cherry 10" S28°E 42 L.

Set Wexford Co. Monument South 6" Cedar 17.53'; S85°W 16" Cedar 17.48'; N35°W 6" Cedar 24.94'; N45°E 10" Cedar 28.93'; S50°W 28" ± WPS 45.2' (Fargo); N20°W 22"± WPS 35.3' (Fargo).

Fargo Eng. - 1913 - Found & section of E-W Road. No other evidence found. I control of E-W Road. WPS 22" N20 1/4°W 53 iron pipe and crockery. WWPS 28" S51°W 68 1/2 L. 1913 - Found 2 stakes- one very old in V Road. No other evidence found. Set crockery. WPS 22" N20 1/4°W 53 1/2 L.;

LCRC - L. 4, P. 60 and Rec. Sur. L. 69, P. 428-429-J. A. Ray - 1990 - Found old witness trees (Fargo 1913)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

E10 – 1/4 Cor. Common to Sec. 28 & 29 – On Feb. 25, 2003 – Found Wexford Co. Alum. Monument lying on its side, disturbed and frozen on ground. Set spike per 3 of Ray's Witnesses for point. Spike falls in old overgrown E-W track through woods. Fits distances to remains of Fargo's W. Pine Stp. BT's as noted by Ray. Returned on April 28, 2003. Wexford Co. Monument gone and spike pulled. Area for corner is soft swampy area. Dug in area searching for crockery or stakes, but nothing found. Set 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 5' long galv. Iron pipe per Ray's Witnesses. Set DNR Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E10 — 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 5' galv. Iron pipe.

Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' SW

Set steel fence post 1' E

N32°W 24.94' to found nail in E. side 9" Cedar (JAR)

N42°E 28.93' to found nail in NW side 13" Cedar (JAR)

S3°E 17.53' to found nail in W side 11" Cedar (JAR)

S58°W 40.32' to set N & T in SE side 18" Cedar scribed 'XBT' er: MICL MICHICA
