A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1849 - Township subdivision by James H. Mullett, D.S. Original B.Ts: Cedar 12" - N35°E, 17 links; cedar 10" - S46°E, 32 links.

1915 - Dickinson Co. Rd. Commission map shows C.II. Found a 2" stake w/tack.

1934 - Dickinson Co. Rd. Commission R/W map shows corner lying 980 feet south of road centerline and 2615.3 feet east to 1/4 corner.

1950 - WEPCO map shows iron pin at corner.

WEPCO section diagram of unknown date indicates a well point at section corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1 1/2" well point on N-S fence line. Blue line running north, south, east and west from well point. Three existing recently blazed bearing trees were also found facing the well point. Accepted well point as corner position. Given the record chain of evidence and the use and acceptance of the existing corner location. I am accepting the well point as marking the correct corner position.

Replaced well point with aluminum Dickinson County monument and established the following references: existing 6" cedar B.T. - N03°W, 8.46 feet; existing 6" cedar B.T. - S27°E, 25.29 feet; 5" cedar - S64°W, 37.60 feet; existing 4" cedar - N49°W, 20.30 feet; set carsonite witness post - East, 2.0 feet.
