A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Austin Burt on 9/8/1847. Original bearing trees:

Yellow Birch 10" S.62½° W. 30 links (19.80')  
Lynn 14" N.55½° E. 36 links (23.76')

Corner restored by Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585 on 8/30/72 from the remains of the two original B.T.s. He set a 2" X 5' iron pipe monument with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following new bearing trees:

Sugar Maple 10" N.35° W. 12.5'  
Sugar Maple 7" N.35° E. 23.5'  
Sugar Maple 6" S.57° E. 10.0'  
Metal sign post 6' North 3.2'

Corner recorder in Gogebic County USFS Liber, Page M-11 on 12/9/74.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I recovered the monument as described and the bearing trees as follows:

Sugar Maple 11" N.37° W. 12.13' (new nail)  
Sugar Maple 10" N.35° E. 23.32' (new nail)  
Sugar Maple 8" S.60° E. 10.02' (new nail)  
Steel sign rail 6' N.02° E. 3.15'

Fragments of Yellow Birch wood and bark remain from the Yellow Birch B.T.. Only a stump hole remain from the Lynn B.T.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

New bearing tree referenced:

Sugar Maple 10" S.39° W. 45.72'
