I, John R. Garske, in a field survey on September 13, 19 95, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original township survey by John and William Burt, D.S., September 1847.

Original township subdivision by William Burt, D.S., 1848. Original bearing trees: Set cedar post:
 Fir 5" - N10°E, 5 links
 Cedar 8" - S5°E, 15 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a 3 7/8" I.D. iron pipe with a brass cap with a punch mark in the center with no stamping. The monument is similar to monuments found on the west side of the section set by the Gogebic County Park Commission, date unknown. A single proportional position falls S28°-05'-15"E, 41.63 feet from this monument. No evidence was found at the proportioned point. A standing dead 14" cedar blazed bears S10°E, 9.90 feet from the monument matching the original B.T. reasonably well. Also blazed, ribboned lines run north, east and west. The distance of 10.9 chains west (719.4') to the east bank of the Black River checks very well to the monument. I am accepting the monument as being the best position for the one-quarter corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Accepted the 3 7/8" I.D. iron pipe with brass cap and established the following bearing trees/objects:

- 5" S. maple - S68°E, 18.95 feet
- 7" ash - S62°W, 46.41 feet
- 7" S. maple - N10°E, 48.15 feet
- Steel Sign Post - S70°W, 1.22 feet
