1875: F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; "Found old stake with stone around. Set marked stone. Cherry 6" N. 49°-40' E. 74 3/4lks., W. Ash 6" S. 73°-30' E. 128 lks."

1883: F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; "Replaced stone of resurvey with 3 ft. earthen post and noted new witness. Maple 3" North 42 lks."

1940: Wilkins & Wheaton Engineering Co.; Found tile down 30", set iron above.

1997: Found PK Nail under 3" of bituminous paving. Found 1/2" iron 9" below surface (18" long). Found tile down 40" below surface. (From 1940 Walnut trees witnesses, see above).

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

B-11: South 1/4 post, Section 30, T. 3 S., R. 9 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on July 16, 1997 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Found 3" round tile with "x" on top 40" below surface. Tile was set in 1883 remonumentation survey by F. Hodgman, County Surveyor. Set 20" Harrison Monument to within 3" of surface and placed monument box over.
