Vallier, in a field survey on November 14, 2000 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1837 John Mullett (G.L.O.) set post corners in Towns 9 and 10 North, Ranges 13 and 14 West.

S 87° W 10" Beech 24 Links
- 1885 Old County survey records, Page 23, note section corner being re-established:  
N 22° W 12" Maple 8 ½ Links  
N 53° E 14" Hemlock 15 Links  
S 49° E 18" Maple 7 ½ Links
- 1968 Consumers Power Company (No. S-F 16758) shows distance from L-1 to M-1 as 2602.0'. No witnesses.
- 1982 C. F. Lewandowski found a 1" iron pipe and reset with a 4" x 32" cast-iron monument with a "County Surveyor Legend."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A 4" x 32" cast-iron monument with "County Surveyor Legend" was found. Fence lines to South and West. Witnesses check with L.C.R.C. Liber 1242, Page 310. Position of the existing corner accepted due to historical usage and documentation.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

- A 4" x 32" cast-iron monument with a "County Surveyor Legend" was found. Fence Corner is 0.5' North and 1.7' East.
