B. DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND/OR METHOD APPLIED IN RESTORING OR REESTABLISHING CORNER:

Found Railroad Spike in centerline of the North and South bituminous road and on tree line going East and on fence line going West. The condition of the recorded witnesses are: #1 thru #6 gone, #7 and #8 good condition, #9 post leaning, #10 gone, #11 flat, #12 thru #14 good condition.

C. DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT FOR CORNER AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE LOCATING THE POSITION OF THE CORNER:

Removed Railroad Spike and set a 2 3/4" diameter Harrison cast iron monument 18" long marked "County Survey" in monument box as a substantial marker for the quarter corner and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

- 32" Maple N15°W 161.95' Found spike in Northwest side of tree. #7
- Power Pole West 66.93' Found P.K. in North side of pole. #8
- Fence Post (leaning) S80°W 35.85' Found spike in Southeast side of post. #9
- 10" Elm S40°E 47.58' Found spike in Southwest side of tree. #12
- Clump Apple Trees S85°E 37.68' Found spike in South side of tree. #13
- 8" Elm N33°E 54.63' Found spike in Northeast side of tree. #14
