B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

A13: Found 3/4" x 24" square headed bolt author unknown, 0.7 feet east of centerline of road and six inches deep. Verified references of the 1989 LCRC report by Larry Bussone, RLS, 1989. A search was made at the GLO bearing tree locations, no evidence found. Installed new monument and established additional references.
