C3: PLS - Z.B. Searls, DS, 1850, Set post corner of Sections 5-6-7 & 8 * Sugar 10, S.55 W., 27 links * Sugar 12, N.32 E., 21 links ***** Minneapolis, Ste.Paul and Sault Ste. Marie Railroad Right of Way Map, October 27, 1901. * Corner position noted as being at Station 1475+40 and lying seventy (70) feet East of the centerline of railroad right of way. * Map filed November 20, 1902 at Alger County Register of Deeds. ***** Edwin Swan, RLS, 1948. * Alger County Road Commission alignment notes for the Eben-Trenary Road. * Section line crossing noted at Station 450+74 which is also the P.I. of the curve tangents of the centerline of the Eben-Trenary Road. * Computed (by Swan) location of the corner position was noted to be at Station 450+74 and 47.8 feet West of the centerline of the roadway. * Also noted was a low area to the south with twin crossing culverts, beginning at Station 441+00 and ending at Station 442+70, 804 feet and 974 feet respectively. * Alignment notes filed at the Alger County Road Commission. *****

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C3: Established corner position at the intersection of the Eben-Trenary road, Wertanen road (West) and W. Cold Springs road (East). * North-South position of the corner was determined at centerlines of East-West roads above. AND 1948 A.C.R.C. alignment notes of Low Area and Twin Culvert crossings to the South on the Eben-Trenary road. * The notes of the GLO of 1850 call for a Begin swamp, Brook, 5 links, C. East and End swamp. These calls index well with the A.C.R.C. Low area and Culvert crossings mentioned above. * Mean distance from the twin culvert position to the corner position is 855 feet and GLO calls for 858 feet. * East-West position of the corner was determined at 70 feet East, (M.S.& S.S.M.R.R., 1902 distance) from centerline of abandoned railroad grade lying West of the Eben-Trenary road. * Corner position lies 12 feet West of the centerline of roadway. * Bearings and distances to corner positions North, South and East agree well with the survey index of this area. * Monumented corner position as established. * Corner position is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C3: Set 5/8" X 18" Rebar with 3 1/4" Berntsen Aluminum cap no. RBD5325, stamped to identify corner position. * Set PK nails with aluminum I.D. washers for measure in the following reference objects. * P.Pole, S.49 E., 56.40 feet to PK mail, scribed "BT" at base. * P.Pole, S.23 W., 35.61 feet to PK mail, scribed 'BT' at base. * Spruce 4", N.47 W., 68.49 feet to PK mail, BT signs, Blazed and scribed "BT" at base, painted. * Steel post of "Buried Telephone Cable" sign, N.61 E., 52.44 feet. * All bearings are magnetic.
