I, Robert L. Jamros, in a field survey on October 24, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

**NOTE:** Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

**A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:**

**J07:** PLS Geo. E. Adair, DS, 1851. Set quarter section post. Spruce 7", N.21°E., 20 links. W. Pine 10", S.58°W., 09 links. \*\*\*\*\* C.C.I. Co. T.J. McLaren, cruiser. Set post from original BT, W. Pine stump, S.58°W., 09 links. Sugar 3", N.40°E., 33½ links. Tamarack 6", S.23°E., 07 links. Unrecorded report of 1967. \*\*\*\*\* No other subsequent restoration of record.

**B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:**

**J07:** Established corner position at the midpoint and on line between section corners ½ mile East and West. Post and Sugar BT of 1967 report lost and only remains of the Tamarack BT decayed stump are evident. Post position located for decayed Tamarack stump lies approximately 20 feet East and 6 feet South of midpoint position. G.L.O. call on East side of small lake to corner is 0.95 chains, as measured. This date the return is 0.85 chains. Corner position at midpoint and on line is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

**C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:**

**J07:** Set 2½" x 30" Berntsen aluminum monument no. A1NB30 with ¾" aluminum cap stamped to identify corner position. Established reference trees with BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. Set PK nails for measure with aluminum I.D. washers in the following: Spruce 7", N.14°E., 14.48 feet (¾S BT); Balsam 5", N.63°E., 16.72 feet (¾S BT); Hemlock 7", S.33°E., 28.37 feet (¾S BT); W. Pine 14", S.00°E., 19.35 feet (¾S BT). Survey marker sign on 6 foot steel post, S.80°W., 1.0 feet. All bearings are magnetic.
