Fd. remains of 4 of 5 Roser wifs – all dead or stp s that fits pipe. 1 ½" pipe consistent with Lucas survey. Also searched 33" N for possible 1911 position but no evidence of cedar post or stones. Possibly the NW WPS BT remains. Appears the County Surveyor from 1914 didn't agree with the 1911 position. Neither Co. Surveyor had original evidence. Pipe from 1914 found by CCC survey and used by MODT in 1965. 1914 Survey Map says "Authority for Survey — By order of Township Board and the Highway Commission of Adam Township."
