(14-Sec. 15) South 1/16 corner between Sections 14 and 15. Not established in the original survey.

- (H6) Center of Section 15. Not established in the original survey.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (14-Sec. 15) Established the corner midway and on the Section line between Quarter corner 1315.38' north and Section corner 1315.38' south. The Section corner falls in Coon Lake and is not monumented. For the purpose of the establishment of this 1/16 corner, the position of Section corner I7 was computed by double proportionate measurement to the original record between corners G7, J7, I6, and I8. The position for the 1/16 corner falls on exposed granite. The monument is a 1"x10" iron pipe with a 4" alum. MDNR cap and a 5/8"x9" rebar grouted inside, which rebar is grouted into a 3/4"x4" deep hole drilled into the granite.
