A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner G1: Closing Cor. on 5th Corr. Line between Sec. 3 & 4, T50N, R34W:
Sugar post (Not found. See "B" for subsequent monument.)
Hemlock 30 S48W 34 (" " No subsequent accessories found.)
Lynn 20 S34E 18 (" " No subsequent accessories found.)

Corner I1: Closing Cor. on 5th Corr. Line between Sec. 2 & 3, T50N, R34W:
Maple post (Not found. See "B" for subsequent monument.)
Hemlock 8 S52W 41 (" " No subsequent accessories found.)
Maple 5 S25E 27 (" " No subsequent accessories found.)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

Corner G1: On 4/10/73 witnessed a monument described in C below, found in an E & W county road while making a retracement survey in this twp. Possibly set by a former local surveyor named Schwalm. Method of setting the corner is unknown, but it falls only 12.5 lks. S and 9.1 lks. E of the computed proportionate position on the 5th Correction Line, which seems to be well within the limits of probability as to original establishment. Distance E to standard twp. corner is 4.115 ch., the record being 4.10 ch.

Corner I1: Re-established 5/6/76 proportionately on 5th Correction Line between standard corners 74.657 ch. W and 7.483 ch. E. Found rotted remnants of a hardwood post N34°W 4.9 ft. and Northern Paper Mills location poster on a nearby tree.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner G1: 3/4" square iron pin, length unknown, buried in road.
NE corner of garage S39°E (mag.) 46.6 ft.
Nail in Power Pole S50°W (mag.) 44.06 ft.
Nail in Sugar Maple 26 N20°W (mag.) 70.04 ft.

Corner I1: 1" I.D. x 36" iron pipe with 3 3/4" aluminum cap.
Red Maple 5 S42°W (mag.) 6.3 ft. "S3, NBT"
Red Maple 4 S53°E (mag.) 9.8 ft. "S2, NBT"
