This corner was considered lost by the Bureau of Land Management during the course of a survey conducted by Stephen Douglas from 10 May 1984 to 10 November 1984 and approved 23 September 1985. The BLM reestablished this corner midway and on line between section corners immediately to the east and to the west and

"set a railroad spike, driven flush with the surface, in the intersection of an asphalt road, bears E. and S., and a graded gravel road, bears W.".
