- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- 11 SW 1/16 Corner Sec. 13 Found bent ½" x 18" iron rebar with smashed RFM cap in gravel road NW - SE; 1.5'± West of centerline. No evidence of Haswell's post was found. Bent ½" capped iron rod accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the corner.

 $\underline{12}$ – CS 1/16 Corner Sec. 13 – Found 1½" pipe, $\pm\,2$ ½" up from ground that is 4'± N of calculated SP position, barb wire on ground N & W. Dug around and under pipe, but found no evidence of Haswell's cedar post. At calculated SP position, excavated area for evidence of post, but area is embedded with roots from S. Maple tree and all evidence of Haswell's cedar post was assumed to be obliterated by the tree growth. Corner position falls on SW root of 14" S. Maple thus set 2" aluminum cap on 8" spike in Maple root per standard BLM procedure.
