Found numerous very rotten cedar logs & a few rotten remains of Tamarack stps. in this area but nothing conclusive. Set 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 8' long galv. Iron pipe per Tuller's record distance S. from K9 & West from L10. Monument accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner. Reference Pt. – Found N. Livasy capped iron- N35°09' W 73.87' of K10. This iron appears to have been establishing by doubling down S. a fence corner near the N 1/16 corner. Could not accept N. Livasy iron as K10 because 1) Doesn't fit Tuller's historical survey in Sec. 25. 2) Fence line that runs south from K9 is extension of section line between Sec. 23 & 24 extended south, couldn't accept fence as representing section line between Sec. 25&26. 3) Fence corner used by N.
