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Part B: Surveyor's Report on Perpetuation or Monumentation of Corner(s)

I-3 – Corner common to Sections 2, 3, 10, and 11, T26N, R14W – Found 4" DNR Aluminum Cap on 1" x 2.6' long iron pipe per Roser. Corner in Red Pine Plantation. Post fallen. Condition of witnesses as follows: 1 & 2 are gone; #3 is dead; #4, 5, and 6 are OK. The corner at 'I-5' has been revised being about 2.9' further south than the position used by Roser. This would make a double proportion position 1.5'± further south for 'I-3'. Could not justify moving this corner position such a small amount. Thus accepted the DNR Monument as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
