I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on December 21, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

F-11 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 28 & 33, T44N, R2W

- 1845 - Original corner (12" Aspen) established by James Mullett.
1905 - Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown, RLS 944, notes for Section 28 show corner midway on line section corners 2650 feet east and 2650 feet west.
1915 - Brown's notes for Section 33 show essentially the same distances as Section 28 notes. Brown specifically notes that this 1/4 corner is gone, in second growth.
1995 - Certificate of Survey, liber 661, page 287, Chippewa County records. Corner is shown as a found boat spike, raised with 1/2" rod.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being reestablished as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program. Found no evidence of the original corner. Found the 1/2" rod as shown on above mentioned Certificate of Survey as recorded in liber 661, page 287. According to 1961 plans for Highway I-75 (Project #17033A, C5 & C6RN, sheet #6) the boat spike which the 1/2" rod was placed over is an alignment P.O.T. at Station 202+30.00, and was not intended to represent the 1/4 corner F-11. I reestablished the 1/4 corner F-11 by single proportionate measurement midway on line between section corners at E-11 2651.0 feet west and at G-11 2651.0 feet east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a 3/4" x 24" rebar with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, which falls in the median of Highway I-75, 50.3 feet from the centerline of the northbound lanes and 43.6 feet from the centerline of the southbound lanes. Witnesses:

- Nail and witness tag in Power Pole (RU2/24B/35), S81°E 165.78'
Nail and witness tag in Power Pole (RU2/24B/36), S81°W 152.35'
Nail and witness tag in Guard Rail Post (north end), N83°E 179.81'
Nail and witness tag in 4" Balsam Fir, N85°W 134.54'
1/2" Iron Rod (over boat spike at P.O.T. Station 202+30.00), N21°E 9.60'
