

Rogers, P.S. 29251, recovered 1 3/4" iron pipe on extension of old fence to East. Corner was accepted as found and filed in Liber 9, Page 105 of the Chippewa County Corner Records. MACON

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G-2) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 3 and 4, T45 N., R.1 E.

This corner is being re-established as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.
