I, Larry R. Rogers, in a field survey on October 22, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below

**NOTE:** Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(G-5) Corner Common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, T.45 N., R.1 E.

Original corner post was placed in September, 1845 by James H. Mullett. 1900 County Surveyor notes show no evidence found of original corner position. 1996 recorded survey by Ronald Bischer, P.S. 22428, indicate he set a 1/2" iron pin at a found squared cedar post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G-5) Corner Common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, T.45 N., R.1 E.

This corner is being re-established as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found 1/2" iron pin and three Bischer witnesses. Corner is 1' East of squared cedar post, 2' North of fence to West and 9' East of fence to South. Bischer notes indicate a North-South fence 14' East of corner but fence has apparently been removed. Accepted corner position as found and established one new witness.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G-5) Corner Common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, T.45 N., R.1 E.

Corner is a 1/2" iron pin 1' East of squared cedar post.
