I, Larry R. Rogers in a field survey on October 15, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the

Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: C-4) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 7 and 8, Township 46 North, Range 2 East.

A 6" aspen was marked at the original corner position in 1845 by James H. Mullett. County Surveyor records make no specific reference to corner. In a 1975 B.L.M. dependent resurvey the corner position was re-established "latitudinally at proportionate distillationally on the projection of a blazed line to the N", but attached plat of survey shows corner to be set midway and on-line between Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 7.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: (C-4) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 7 and 8, Township 46 North, Range 2 East.

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

OVUMENT Recovered B.L.M. 2 1/2" iron pipe with stamped brass cap and both witness trees - now both dead. Distance to Northeast comier of Section 7 is 2643.24 feet (B.L.M. 2641.98 feet) and distance to Southeast Corner of Section 7 is 2643.71 feet (B.L.M. 2641.98 feet). Corner is within 0.4 feet of being midway and on line between Northeast and Southeast corners of Section 7. Accepted corner position as found and established four new witnesses.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C-4) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 7 and 8, Township 46 North, Range 2 East. Corner is a 2 1/2" iron pipe with stamped B.L.M. aluminum cap 6" above ground.
